

Requirements for proofs (PDF) for electronic object comparison

Edition: October 2008

Generally use PDF as file format for proofing

The approved pattern from the customer must be the basis for the verification with object comparison

The Edelmann-die line has to be integrated within the artwork

Die line and varnished areas have to be set up in a colour/layer, which is not used elsewhere in the document

The background of the PDF-file must be pure white

For creation of the PDF-file, please see to the Edelmann-documentation

All fonts have to be embedded into the PDF-file

The PDF-file name should be the material or article number

The PDF-file must not be scaled, it must be 100% size

There must nor be any comments or modifications signed onto the approved PDF-file or printout from the customer

The PDF-file must be composite, i. e. all colours on one page

Braille / security texts including the die line have to be set up in an additional page or a separate file in the PDF-format or printout in a legible colour

The resolution of the PDF-file must be 2400 dpi

It is necessary to inspect the PDF-file with Enfocus PIT STOP or PDF X3 Inspector before sending it to Edelmann
